The Bourne Show, which takes place this year on Saturday, July 18th, from 12.30pm to 5pm, has a long and colourful history

This will be the 68th year of the event, which makes the most of its idyllic setting and carnival atmosphere and is one of the high points of the Farnham summer season.

Great attractions this year include a climbing wall, bungee trampolines, giant inflatable slides, Kiln Stables pony rides and the Old Kiln Forge.

The show, sponsored by Charters Estate Agents, typifies the traditional English fete, with all generations coming together for the festivities.

Centre-stage will be the Grand Marquee, home to an impressive array of entries to the arts and crafts, and home produces classes. Equally impressive are the flower-arranging entries on display in St Martin's Church.

The Vintage Car Show will take place, starting with a Saturday morning drive for the car-owners before

returning to the green for visitors to enjoy the vehicles. The drive starts at the Fox Pub at 10.30am.

New this year a wide range of food stalls will offer a selection of lunchtime treats, which will complement the teas provided by the Bourne WI and barbecue and refreshments at the cricket pavilion. Other attractions will include Punch & Judy shows, a teddy bear competition, climbing wall, music from the Alder Valley Brass Band, football competition, a dressage demonstration, mini fairground and the famous dog show.

The day will end with a barn dance in the Grand Marquee, where the community will gather to celebrate another successful show – tickets have sold out for this event.
