There's the Scarecrow in need of a brain, the Tin Man who needs a heart, the cowardly Lion who wants some courage and of course, Dorothy who just wants to get back home. But what will happen on their way to Oz as they encounter the Wicked Witch of the West? Will the ruby slippers help take you to **The Phoenix in Bordon** to enjoy superb songs, laugh out loud comedy and lots of opportunity for you to join in and have a great time. *The Wizard of Oz* is on 16th to 18th and 23rd to 25th January.
